



READY FOR THE NEW NORMAL

One lesson we've taken away from our experience with the Coronavirus is that individual actions truly do effect everyone's health. With that in mind, we are optimistic that our community will press ahead with sustainability efforts on set. Making eco-conscious choices can be safe and hygienic, as well as smart for our collective well-being.

Disposable doesn't equate to safe and hygienic. Just because something is meant to be thrown away doesn't mean it hasn't been handled by others. What matters is the chain-of-use, not the object being used.

CHANGES WE'RE IMPLEMENTING FOR HEALTH & SAFETY:

GENERAL KIT AND STAFFING

Our PAs will arrive with their own masks, gloves, anti-septic alcohol wipes, hand sanitizer and Ultraviolet-C lamps to keep CO2CYCLE's set-up clean and healthy.

We recognize you may have to limit the number of people in your crew, so if we're done with our work and you need help, our team will jump in to assist with things that don't require technical experience.

WATER SERVICE

Reverting to unmarked plastic bottles or boxed water simply increases the chances of someone else touching your anonymous bottle in search of their own.

We recommend more than ever that people bring a bottle from home that's clearly theirs. If they don't, we'll supply one that's refillable, along with a label and color carabiner. The more it looks like yours, the less likely it is that someone else will touch it.

Our PAs will operate the water dispenser for you with gloved hands. They will use antiseptic wipes frequently and regularly to wipe down the buttons and other surfaces if they step away.

A portable Ultraviolet-C light will also be used to sterilize the buttons and dispensing nozzle.

We will use disposable paper funnels in the mouth of each bottle to keep it distanced from the dispensing nozzle. Signage will ask people to use the funnel and avoid contact with the nozzle if the PA has stepped away.

An ultraviolet-C lamp will be available by the phone charger area to sterilize cell phones, and to keep the wires clean.

CATERING/CRAFT

We continue to believe that reusable china and utensils cleaned in the caterer's high-temperature washer are the best materials for a clean service.

Going forward, the only way to ensure sanitary service will be for the catering server to control the entire process, from picking up the plate to putting everything onto it that the person wants. Our palm ware works just as effectively in place of ceramics as a stack of disposable plastic plates.

Utensils will need to be given out in sets by the server. Our bamboo and birch utensils still work just as well as an alternative to plastic.

Our recyclable paper coffee cups remain the best disposable alternative to typical non-recyclable versions. We recommend your caterer/craft service bring individual creamers.

TRASH

There is going to be a lot more trash on set as people use materials one time or throw away supplies they aren't sure are still sanitary.

We will continue to make sure that all of the trash is properly sorted and frequently emptied so there is minimal accumulation in the bins, and will keep all surfaces sanitized and tidy.

PROPS AND SET PIECES

If you intend to dispose of any props and set pieces, we will do our very best to work with our partner, Eco-Set, to accept as many of them as possible.
